CLASSES THAT ARE COMBINED MAY BE SPLIT, PROVIDED THERE ARE 3 OF EACH SEX

CLASSES WILL GO IN ORDER AS LISTED. Six Ribbons in each class

- CLASS 1 PENNSYLVANIA BRED YEARLING COLTS AND GELDINGS
- CLASS 2 THOROUGHBRED AND NON-REGISTERED THOROUGHBRED YEARLING COLTS AND GELDINGS
- CLASS 3 NON- THOROUGHBRED YEARLING COLTS AND GELDINGS
- CLASS 4 PENNSYLVANIA BRED YEARLING FILLIES

CLASS 17 BEST PENNSYLVANIA HORSE AND RESERVE

CLASS 18 BEST YOUNG HORSE AND RESERVE

CLASS 19 AMATEUR OR JUNIOR HANDLER (PHSA POINTS ONLY)

Horse or pony to be shown on the line by an Amateur or Junior. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, and the overall condition of the animal. Conformation will not be a determining factor. The class is intended for the sole purpose of stimulating participation of the Amateur and Junior in the Breeding Division and does not limit that person to the class above.

CLASS 20 YOUNG WORKING HUNTER UNDER SADDLE (PHSA POINTS ONLY)

Five year olds and under suitable to become hunters. Open to horses registered with the PHSA and whose owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter-not to jump. Performance, soundness, manners and way of going.

CLASS 21 YOUNG HUNTER UNDER SADDLE (PHSA POINTS ONLY)

Five year olds and under suitable to become hunters. Open to horses registered with the PHSA and whose owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter-not to jump. Conformation 50%, performance, soundness, manners and way of going 50%. Two or more horses than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation.

Open to mares 4 yrs. And older suitable to produce hunter pony foals. To be shown at the walk, not to jog. Not restricted by height though height suitability may be considered in judging. May not cross enter into the mare (horse) 4 yrs. and older suitable to produce at the same show.

CLASS 31 PHPBA YEARLING, 2 YEAR OLD AND 3 YEAR OLD PONIES (PHPBA POINTS ONLY)

CLASS 32 PENNSYLVANIA BRED HUNTER PONY CHAMPION AND RESERVE

CLASS 33 HUNTER PONY CHAMPION AND RESERVE

CLASS 34 YOUNG HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE (PHSA POINTS ONLY)

Five year olds and under suitable to become hunter ponies. Open to ponies registered with the PHSA and whose owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter-not to jump. Conformation 50%, performance, soundness, manners and way of going 50%. Two or more ponies than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation. Adult or Junior can ride.

Mile View Farm Breeding Shows ***Rules & Regulations***

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be judged in accordance therewith.
2. Management and Mile View Farm are not responsible for any accidents, financial loss, or damages of any kind for any reason including financial loss or damage resulting from acts of God.
3. No numbers will be issued until entries are paid and all entry blanks are signed.
4. All protests will be handled in accordance with USEF GR 602.
5. A \$50.00 charge will be imposed upon any returned check.
6. Negative Coggins test issued after June 1, 2017 is required.
7. Post entries permitted. Mail-in or faxed entries encouraged.
8. No dogs, please.
9. All riders must wear proper attire including proper protective headgear at all times when mounted on the show grounds.
10. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and / or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and / or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
